# The Kinsey Interview Kit

Compiled and Edited by Joan Scherer Brewer



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### INTRODUCTION

Alfred C. Kinsey was a biology professor at Indiana University when, in 1938, he was asked to teach a course in marriage. It was felt that such a course should incorporate information about sex, but at the time little scientific data on the subject was available. Kinsey began questioning students about their own experiences, gradually including other students, faculty members, and people out in the surrounding communities. In time he developed a standardized list of questions, a pattern for questioning, and a method of recording the data in a secret code. Kinsey's emphasis on confidentiality resulted in the development of a series of steps assuring complete and permanent secrecy regarding the identity of interviewees. This strict policy of confidentiality was maintained by Kinsey's successor, Paul H. Gebhard, and it continues to be observed. No names were ever affixed to individual data sheets; instead, each was coded and the key to that code has been locked away and is permanently secure from access by unauthorized individuals. Even the coded data sheets are available to only a limited number of Institute employees with special permission. However, the data itself, which ultimately incorporated the results of interviews with a nation-wide sample of over 18,000 histories, has with the help of NIMH grant MH-0772 been entered into a computer file and is available for research projects by qualified researchers.

One of the main conclusions of a committee appointed by the Commission on Statistical Standards of the American Statistical Association to review the statistical methods used in <u>Sexual Behavior in the Human Male</u> (A. C. Kinsey, W. B. Pomeroy and C. E. Martin. W. B. Saunders, 1948) was that in the systematic coverage of the material, the number of items covered, the number and variety of methodological checks employed, and the method of interviewing, the Kinsey methodology was

superior to all the other leading sex studies of the period. (Cochran, Mosteller and Tukey, 1953).

This <u>Interview Packet</u> has been compiled in order to assist other researchers to gather contemporary data; to add to or to update, to challenge or to verify the initial findings of the Kinsey studies. The Institute's Information Service provides access to the original statistical data, and conducts bibliographic searches of its unparalleled collection of literature related to human sexuality. Under the leadership of the current director, June Machover Reinisch, Ph.D., the Institute continues research furthering understanding in this most fundamental area of human knowledge.

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### INTERVIEWING METHOD

Our interviewing is best described in terms of three phases: a prologue. a data-gathering phase, and a concluding phase. The prologue varied in length according to how much the respondent knew of our work and how much reluctance or hesitancy was manifest. Consequently, the prologue varied in duration from perhaps two minutes to ten. We felt that the respondent was entitled to know the aim of the research, the nature of the Institute, the safeguards employed, the general structure of the interview, and—most importantly—that we made no evaluations or judgments. We did not distance ourselves from the respondent by assuming a coldly objective impersonal role; this is an error commonly found today. Instead, we presented ourselves as interested and sympathetic researchers who were asking the respondent to help us in obtaining information of great social benefit. Many respondents were naturally curious as to what sort of individual they were about to entrust their secrets; we were quite willing to give information as to our marital status, professional background, and similar items. We never divulged our own sexual histories or preferences, parrying any query by saying, "I'm sorry, but we keep our own histories just as confidential as we will keep yours."

A vital part of the prologue was expressing sincere appreciation of the respondent's willingness to cooperate, and we assured everyone that his or her contribution was valuable regardless of what it did or did not contain. We also observed the social amenities: shaking hands, offering a chair, and making a small variety of eigarettes and matches available. We took pains to seat ourselves at a normal conversational distance making sure that no table or desk was interposed to render the situation like an interrogation.

During the prologue some respondents who were uncertain of the interviewer's objectivity tried to trap us into making a value judgment. For example, the respondent may have asked, "Don't you think it is terrible the way some of these young people today are behaving?" If the interviewer agreed, he labeled himself a conservative; if he disagreed, he was viewed as amoral or possibly immoral. The answer was neither to agree nor disagree but to make some neutral objective remark such as saying that rapid social and technological changes are producing stressful re-examination of previously unquestioned standards, and it is all the more important that research be done so that we can better solve our social and personal problems.

The data-gathering phase which constituted the bulk of the interview consisted of asking our questions in a sequence beginning with the least sensitive subjects (e.g., demographic items) and gradually working to the most sensitive as rapport developed. The sequence was, however, not immutable. If a person seemed anxious to discuss some topic and resisted being held to our sequence, we accommodated. Also, respondents inevitably gave data out of sequence; it behooved the interviewer to record this at the moment rather than to ignore an item and ask about it subsequently. For example, in inquiring about past residence, a respondent may have said, "When my parents moved to Detroit, my aunt was able to take care of me because I was an only child." It would have been a serious error to fail to record this and some minutes later inquire as to brothers and sisters. The respondent was apt to interpret such a faux pas as meaning the interviewer was not paying attention. Rapport was increased by remembering and making this evident. In the example cited, when coming to the subject of siblings, the interviewer would have said, "You mentioned you were an only child, but were there any brothers or sisters who had died?"

One of the most vital aspects of data gathering is to ask the questions clearly and frankly. Euphemism must be avoided like the plague since it may not result only in misperception of the question, but it shows the interviewer is embarrassed. The respondent too should be discouraged from using euphemisms. Pomeroy was famous for quickly eradicating such terms; when a person said "we slept together" he would, with a straight face and interested look inquire, "and did you have intercourse?" Certain other words and phrases should be stricken from the interviewer's vocabulary; "Did you ever . . . ," "indulge in," "resort to," etc.

To make the admission of behavior easier we placed the burden of denial on the respondent. For example, we never asked if the person had ever masturbated but instead asked how old was he or she when masturbation began. Note the assumption that the activity occurred and the suggestion that it began as a natural event rather than a volitional act. Periodic reassuring and supportive comments were employed, particularly in connection with sensitive topics. These were not phrased so as to encourage exaggeration—the admission of bizarre or extreme behavior was not rewarded—but were non-evaluative remarks such as "It's good you remember so accurately," "I see," or "That often happens."

We maintained what is best described as an elastic control of the interview, keeping the respondent within the limits of the desired subject matter. Sometimes it was necessary to firmly but inoffensively interrupt by saying, "That's interesting, but let's take it up later; now let's finish what we were talking about."

A lengthy complex statement by a respondent was usually concisely rephrased by the interviewer to ascertain if he had correctly grasped the essentials.

While the point of each question was clearly fixed, the phraseology was sometimes altered to suit the understanding of the respondent and to enhance rapport, although in the majority of cases a middle- to upper-middle-class vocabulary sufficed. With a physician we would employ terms such as coitus, erectile impotence, and orgasm, whereas with a poorly-educated person we would refer instead to "sexual intercourse," "trouble getting hard," and "coming." Artificiality and condescension were scrupulously avoided. In particular situations (e.g., interviewing homosexuals) we used a limited amount of argot to demonstrate that we were conversant with the respondent's milieu and to increase rapport but argot was used with caution since misuse can be disastrous.

The interviewer actively assisted in getting correct ages and chronological sequences of events whenever the respondent had difficulty. This was done by referring to salient points in life. Thus, the interviewer would say, "Let's see now, was that before you went in the army?" or "Was that right after the divorce or was it while you were in Chicago?" Obviously, we had to keep the individual's life history continuously in mind which is something any expert interviewer must do. Similarly, the matter of frequencies of activity sometimes required the interviewer's help. Unusually high frequencies were viewed with suspicion and brought forth additional questions. For example, a man who had served in the army in Italy in World War II might say that during his stay in Italy he had coitus "nearly every day." Such an unlikely frequency would elicit a conversation similar to the following:

Interviewer: You said you were in Italy eleven months. How much time did you spend in combat?

Respondent: Oh, it added up to maybe five months or so.

Interviewer: And in those five months how often did you have intercourse?

Respondent (laughing): When you are up front you don't have any. You are too busy keeping alive.

Interviewer: Well, let's see now. Nearly every day would be about six times a week, but you were up front half the time so for that whole eleven months it would only average out to about three a week, right?

Respondent: Yes, I guess it would alright.

Interviewer: So when you weren't up front were you able to get off base six times a week? (slightly incredulous tone)

Respondent: Oh no. Our C.O. was tough about passes. We'd only get to town twice a week.

Interviewer: And each time you got to town would you have intercourse once or more than once?

Respondent: By the time you caught up with your drinking you only had enough money left for once.

Interviewer: Okay, let's do some arithmetic. You were having sex twice a week when you were not up front, but you were up front half the time. So that averages once a week for the whole time in Italy. Does that seem about right?

Respondent: Yes. You know when I think about sex in Italy I just think of the times in Naples.

By this laborious but necessary procedure, an unlikely coital frequency was reduced from six to once per week. Obviously, we only utilized this technique in cases where our suspicions were aroused and, consequently, exaggerations which fell within the range of probability passed uncorrected.

Deliberate or unconscious falsification was, we believe, detected if it were of consequential magnitude. The case history was essentially a life history and, hence, the component elements were interdependent. We were in a position to repeatedly cross-check the responses. For example, masturbation was generally covered before the other sexual outlets and if a previously stable masturbation frequency suddenly diminished to a substantial extent, we anticipated a compensatory increase in some other activity or an important change in life (e.g., illness). If we did not find a compensatory behavior or adequate explanation as the interview progressed, we became suspicious. These interrelated items in the interview were such that we were able to predict with considerable accuracy the portions of the interview as yet untouched; if our prediction did not materialize, we probed for an explanation. Behavior patterns are singularly stable in adults and dramatic changes put us on the alert.

The importance of the concluding phase of an interview is often underestimated. The respondent is dismissed too often with perfunctory thanks and left feeling exploited. We were aware of this danger particularly because at the terminal part of our interview some subjects were quite emotionally involved. Hence, we provided a "cooling off" concluding phase in which we inquired if there was any additional information of relevance which they could provide, offered them the opportunity to ask questions about sex, and extended our thanks and appreciation. Needless to add, we also sometimes had to employ the usual disengagement devices when the concluding phase overlapped with our next appointment. In the great majority of cases the respondent departed in an emotional state which ranged from quiet satisfaction in having assisted an important project to a sort of euphoria resulting from catharsis. In those rare cases where the individual was markedly upset (as a result of facing the realities of his or her life or from recalling traumatic events) we felt it our obligation to spend more time with them even if it meant delaying or cancelling the next appointment.

The reputation of the Institute and the cooperation of subsequent respondents depended on the feelings of those interviewed and we took pains to see that no one left angry, disappointed, or upset. Thus, those interviewed spread the good word about us, and subsequent respondents came to us with

rapport already established.

#### CODING

The data obtained in each interview are recorded directly in code. Coding at the time of the interview serves several functions: (1) It facilitates recording, making it possible to secure a complete history without slowing up an interview, and without losing rapport with the subject. (2) It preserves the confidence of the record, and this is particularly important in a sex study. (3) It facilitates the transference of the data for statistical analyses. (4) It increases the accuracy of the coding because the subject is present at the time of the operation. Where there is uncertainty about the classification of the data, additional questions may be asked and final determinations may be made on the spot. (5) Coding is of supreme importance in conserving space, making it possible to put the whole of the basic history on a single sheet, or on two sheets in the case of individuals who have especial experience in a particular behavior. It also makes it easier for the investigator to comprehend the whole of such a history since it is possible to correlate any item with any and every other item by a rapid scanning of the page of simple and precisely placed symbols. (6) It facilitates and encourages the systematic coverage of the same items on each and every history. At the end of an interview, a rapid examination of the page will show what items have been missed, and the blank places can be filled before the subject has departed.

The record is made on a ruled form which provides a number of blocks. Each aspect of the sex history is recorded in a particular block or portion of a particular block. The significance of any symbol depends, consequently, upon its position in a particular block on the page.

Each block has its own system of symbols, its own independent code. In each block, the available symbols are sufficient in number to designate all of the categories into which the particular data will be classified during subsequent analysis.

The code used is so flexible that it is possible to handle every type of overt activity and every sort of attitudinal situation.

The code provides for a considerable series of classifications of each item.

Rarely is it a matter of alternative possibilities—of a yes or a no. It is the usual statistical experience that six to a dozen or twenty categories, and occasionally a few more, provide the number of points best designed to establish a curve; and in most instances there should be that many possibilities in the code for each item, in each block.

Where the nature of the code allows, as in using numbers to designate the ages or years involved, more detail than is used in the subsequent analysis may be recorded. It sometimes happens that such detail proves useful in making finer calculations than were originally planned.

The symbols used in coding data include various mathematical signs and numbers for recording ages, the years involved, frequencies, and still other items. In addition, numbers, letters, symbols derived from standard practice in biology, chemistry, physics, and the other sciences, and some unique symbols are employed.

Each interviewer has to memorize the code and learn the significance of each block, as well as the pertinent symbols.

In coding items that are not discrete in nature, it is necessary to make precise definitions to which each coded symbol should apply. The coding done by different interviewers on a project must constantly be checked to provide strict standardization. This is especially important in coding attitudes, intensities of response, and other non-discrete materials.

A four-symbol system is used to code degrees of frequency. A checkmark,  $\nu$ , means yes, positive, affirmative, of course, or always, depending on the context. An X means no, never, negative. A minus sign, -, denotes a small amount, rare, unusual, infrequent. A plus-or-minus sign,  $\pm$ , stands for somewhat, more or less, or not always. For example, in coding the amount of alcohol consumption:

- X no alcohol at all
- an occasional social drink
- ± a few drinks a week and/or getting high on rare occasions
- more than 8 oz. of alcohol a day
- alcoholic

Combinations of these symbols are also used. For instance, something that falls between a check and a plus-or-minus is called a check plus-or-minus  $\not\sim \pm$ . Something so rare that it is almost nonexistent but nevertheless is still mentioned might be recorded as  $-\mathbf{X}$ . These and other variants are illustrated in the chapters on the individual blocks.

When age, frequency, or date is sought, the numbers themselves are often used. If the respondent was 25 years old at the time a certain behavior took place or if he is 5 '11" in height, the actual number, 25 or 5 '11", is inserted on the form.

It is possible to go beyond the scale. For example, if someone not only does not drink alcohol but belongs to the Women's Christian Temperance Union, he or she could be given an XX to emphasize the fact that the response is a very strong negative.

The check system is subjective because the interviewer must very often guess the intensity of the respondent's feeling. For example, if the interviewer asks, "Do you like to cook?" and the respondent replies, "Yes, I like to cook," that might warrant a check, but if the answer is, "Well, yes, I guess I like to cook," that response isn't nearly so enthusiastic and should be recorded as a ±.

It is most important for the interviewer to have his own set of definitions, and to adhere to them consistently. For example, in the coding for alcohol consumptions shown above, different interviewers might use different criteria for light or heavy use.

The code is in part based on degree. For example, a percentage figure is recorded when a prostitute is asked, "What percent of your tricks return to you more than once?" or when the interviewee is asked, "What percent of time do you climax?"

Distributions of frequency are recorded by indicating the number of times above the slash mark, /, and whether the standard is by day, week, month, or year below the slash. If it's by the week, the w is not used, since most people seem to think in terms of weeks.

# For example:

- 4 times a week is recorded 4/
- 4 times a day is recorded 4/d
- 4 times a month is recorded 4/m or 1/
- 4 times a year is recorded 4/y

3 to 4 times a week is recorded 3-4/ once a month can be coded as either 1/m or 1/4 (once every 4 weeks)

Since the interviewer is often obliged to do some mental arithmetic in order to record simply and economically, calculations are made on the basis of a fifty-week year. If something happened six times a year, therefore, it could be recorded as 6/y or 1/8.


A numerical attitude scale from 1 to 4 is used to measure degrees. For example, degrees of marital happiness are recorded as follows:

- 1 very happy
- 2 more happy than unhappy
- 3 more unhappy than happy
- 4 very unhappy

A coding of  $1\rightarrow 4$  means that the marriage began as very happy and changed to very unhappy. A relationship recorded as 2-3 means that it is sometimes more happy than unhappy, and at other times more unhappy than happy.

When the interview is over, the interviewer quickly scans his coded sheet to check whether there are any blanks indicating that a question was not asked. Before the respondent leaves, the interviewer can easily ask these questions to ensure that a complete history has been taken.

"Have you played strip poker with both males and females?" If the response was affirmative a second question was asked. "Did it lead to petting or intercourse?"

No question. The defect was either noticed by the interviewer or was mentioned in answering questions as to health.

"Have you had syphilis?" and "Have you had gonorrhea; the clap?"

"How tall are you without shoes?"

No question. Respondents were given cards to fill out and return in preaddressed stamped envelopes, and were instructed to measure on the top surface from belly to tip of penis.

#### MEASURED LENGTH OF FLACCID PENIS

No question. Respondents were given cards to fill out and return in preaddressed stamped envelopes.

# MEASURED CIRCUMFERENCE OF FLACCID PENIS

No question. Respondents were given cards to fill out and return in preaddressed stamped envelopes, and were instructed to measure at the point of maximum circumference.

No question. Respondents were given cards to fill out and return in preaddressed stamped envelopes, and were instructed to measure at the point of maximum circumference.

"If you were standing up and had an erection, if you looked down at the penis, would it be pointing straight ahead or pointed somewhat to the right or left?"

"When you have an erection, is the shaft of the penis straight or does it curve up, down, right, or left?"

DURATION OF LONGEST CONTINUOUS PENILE ERECTION DURING SOCIOSEXUAL ACTIVITY

"What is the longest time your penis stayed continuously hard during sexual activity with someone?"

# INCIDENCE OF ERECTILE IMPOTENCE IN COITUS OR ATTEMPTED COITUS

"Have you ever had trouble getting or keeping an erection?" "Tell me about it." (probe for frequency and ages). Incidental impotence is defined as (1) justifiable impotence due to drunkeness, fatigue, interruption, etc. and (2) impotence which occurs rarely or infrequently

# FREQUENCY OF MORNING PENILE ERECTION

"How often do you wake up in the morning with an erection?"

### POSITION OF PENIS IN TROUSERS

"On which side of the central seam in your pants do you keep your penis?"

# AMOUNT OF PRE-EJACULATORY SECRETION (COWPER'S GLAND SECRETION)

"When you are sexually excited, but before you come to climax, how much slippery fluid comes out of the penis: one drop? a couple? enough to wet the whole head? enough to drip?"

### NUMBER OF TESTES IN SCROTUM

"Do you have two (testicles, balls)?"

#### WHICH TESTIS LOWER IN SCROTUM

"Which (testicle, ball) hangs lower?"

#### TYPE OF TESTICULAR PATHOLOGY

"Have you ever had your (testicles, balls) swell up or have something wrong with them?" If affirmative reply, probe questions were used.

#### REGULARITY OF MENSTRUAL CYCLE

"How regular are your periods?"

#### AVERAGE LENGTH OF MENSTRUAL CYCLE

"How long is it between your periods?"

## AVERAGE LENGTH OF MENSTRUAL FLOW

"When you have a period, how many days do you usually flow?"

### AMOUNT OF PAIN DURING MENSES

"During your period how much pain is there?"

#### DURATION OF MENSTRUAL PAIN

"How long does the pain last?"

#### USE OF TAMPONS

"Do you use napkins or tampons?"

#### AGE AT ONSET OF MENOPAUSE

"How old were you when you began (menopause, change of life)--began having irregular periods, hot flashes, flooding and things like that?"

#### AGE AT COMPLETION OF MENOPAUSE

"How old were you when you finished (menopause, change of life) and stopped menstruating?"

#### CAUSE OF MENOPAUSE

"What caused menopause?"

### AMOUNT OF VAGINAL LUBRICATION

"When you are sexually excited, does the vagina become slightly wet, moderately wet, or enough to wet the bed?"

### PERIODICITY OF FEMALE SEXUAL RESPONSE

"Do you notice any particular time of the month when it is easier for you to get sexually excited?"

#### AGE HYMEN BROKEN

"How old were you when your (hymen, maidenhead) was broken?" The question was omitted and the age automatically recorded if the respondent reported bleeding at first coitus.

CAUSE OF HYMEN BREAKAGE

"How was it broken?"

MAIN SOURCE OF RESPONDENT'S SEX EDUCATION

"What would you say was the main source of your early knowledge about sex?" This question followed a series of questions as to age and source of knowledge of specific items.

"Was there showing sex organs? Touching sex organs? Putting a finger or object in the vagina? Mouth on sex organs? Putting the penis in the vagina?" This tabulation is of the most advanced technique experienced. Thus, taking white college-educated males as an example, the 4.4% who had inserted something into the vagina had also touched and seen female genitalia, but had not experienced oral-genital or coital contact. However, this is not a Guttman scale since oral-genital contact does not necessarily mean insertions or oral-genital contact had been made.

INCIDENCE OF PREPUBERTAL HOMOSEXUAL TECHNIQUES

"Was there (technique described)?"
This tabulation is of the most advanced technique experienced. It is not a Guttman scale since, for example, oral-genital contact does not pre-suppose insertion of objects or body frictation.

"How often was there masturbation from (age at first masturbation) to (age at some salient point in life)?" Question repeated until pre-marital life span covered.

FREQUENCY (MEAN) PER WEEK OF MASTRUBATION TO ORGASM AMONG THE MARRIED

"How often was there masturbation from (age at marriage) to (some salient point in life)?" Question repeated until length of marriage covered.

FREQUENCY (MEAN) PER WEEK OF MASTURBATION TO ORGASM AMONG THE WIDOWED, SEP-ARATED, OR DIVORCED

"How often was there masturbation from the end of the marriage to (some salient point in life)?" Question repeated until postmarital life covered.

"What was the largest number of times there was masturbation in any one week?"

CURRENT MALE MASTURBATORY TECHNIQUES: MANUAL STIMULATION OF PENIS

"How much of the masturbation is by using the hand on the penis?" "None" means no attempt made. "Try" means an attempt or attempts made, but no orgasm resulted. "Rare" means once or twice.

"How much of the masturbation is purely by thinking about sex, without touching yourself?"

CURRENT FEMALE MASTURBATORY TECHNIQUES: OTHER TECHNIQUES

"What other kinds of masturbation do you use?" (Examples often cited.)
This inloudes use of devices, sadomasochism, urethral or anal insertions, etc.

DURATION OF CONTINUOUS MASTURBATORY STIMULATION BEFORE ORGASM

"How long does it take you to come to climax in masturbation?" "Do you come as soon as you can or do you delay to make it last longer?"

FREQUENCY OF FANTASY ACCOMPANYING MASTURBATION

"During masturbation do you think of things and use your imagination or do you only concentrate on the physical feeling?" (Probe questions then used to ascertain frequency.)

FREQUENCY OF HETEROSEXUAL FANTASY WITH MASTURBATION

"What do you think of during masturbation? Do you think of (opposite gender)?"

FREQUENCY OF HOMOSEXUAL FANTASY WITH MASTURBATION

"What do you think of during masturbation? Do you think of (same gender)?"

FREQUENCY OF SADOMASOCHISTIC FANTASY WITH MASTURBATION

"What do you think of during masturbation? Do you think of giving or receiving pain, being forced to do something, or forcing someone to do something?"

FREQUENCY OF ANIMAL FANTASY WITH MASTURBATION

"What do you think of during masturbation? Do you think of animals?"

FREQUENCY OF BIZARRE FANTASY WITH MASTURBATION

"What other sorts of things do you think of during masturbation?"

PHYSICAL HARM FROM MASTURBATION

"Has masturbation ever done you any physical harm?"

AGE BEGAN WORRY ABOUT MASTURBATION

"Did you worry about masturbation?" If affirmative response, a second question was asked, "How old were you when you began to worry?"

REASON FOR WORRY ABOUT MASTURBATION

"Why did you worry about masturbation?"

AGE CEASED WORRY ABOUT MASTURBATION

"Do you still worry about masturbation?" If negative response, a second question was asked, "How old were you when you stopped worrying?"

REASON FOR NOT WORRYING OR CEASING TO WORRY ABOUT MASTURBATION

"Why did you stop worrying about masturbation?"

INCIDENCE OF SEXUAL DREAMS

If orgasm in sleep: "When you come to climax during sleep, are you dreaming?" If no orgasm in sleep: "Do you have sexual dreams?"

FREQUENCY OF HETEROSEXUAL DREAMS

"Do you dream of (opposite gender)?"

FREQUENCY OF HOMOSEXUAL DREAMS

"Do you dream of (same gender)?"

FREQUENCY OF SADOMASOCHISTIC DREAMS

"Do you dream of giving or receiving pain, being forced to do something, or forcing someone to do something?"

FREQUENCY OF DREAMS OF SEX WITH ANIMALS

"Do you dream of sex with an animal?"

FREQUENCY OF BIZARRE DREAMS

"What other sexual things do you dream of?" Also, bizarre content is sometimes volunteered in answering other dream content questions.

AGE AT FIRST ORGASM DURING SLEEP

"How old were you the first time you came to climax while you were asleep?"

AGE-SPECIFIC INCIDENCE OF ORGASM IN SLEEP AMONG THE NEVER-MARRIED

None. Figures obtained from age and frequency data.

AGE-SPECIFIC INCIDENCE OF ORGASM IN SLEEP AMONG THE MARRIED

None. Figures obtained from age and frequency data.

AGE-SPECIFIC INCIDENCE OF ORGASM IN SLEEP AMONG THE WIDOWED, SEPARATED, OR DIVORCED

None. Figures obtained from age and frequency data.

FREQUENCY (MEAN) PER WEEK OF ORGASM DURING SLEEP AMONG THE NEVER-MARRIED.

"How often did you come to climax in sleep from (age at first experience) to (some salient point in life)?" Question repeated until premarital life span covered.

FREQUENCY (MEAN) PER WEEK OF ORGASM DURING SLEEP AMONG THE MARRIED

"How often did you come to climax in sleep from (age at marriage) to (some salient point in life)?" Question repeated until length of marriage covered.

FREQUENCY (MEAN) PER WEEK OF ORGASM DURING SLEEP AMONG THE WIDOWED, SEPARATED, OR DIVORCED

"How often did you come to climax in sleep from the end of the marriage to (some salient point in life)?" Question repeated until postmarital life covered.

AGE FIRST PREMARITAL PETTING

"How old were you the first time there was any hugging, kissing or petting--anything more than a goodnight kiss?"

FREQUENCY OF PREMARITAL HUGGING

"Was there hugging--much, some, little, or none?"
The "None and offended" category consisted of those who volunteered this information; no question was asked.

FREQUENCY OF PREMARITAL KISSING

"Was there kissing?"

FREQUENCY OF PREMARITAL TONGUE KISSING

"Was there deep kissing or tongue kissing?"

FREQUENCY OF MALE HAND ON NUDE FEMALE BREAST IN PREMARITAL PETTING
"Was there hand on the bare female breast?"

FREQUENCY OF MALE MOUTH ON NUDE FEMALE BREAST IN PREMARITAL PETTING
"Was there mouth on bare female breast?"

FREQUENCY OF MALE HAND ON NUDE FEMALE GENITALS IN PREMARITAL PETTING "Was there hand on nude female sex organ?"

FREQUENCY OF FEMALE HAND ON NUDE PENIS IN PREMARITAL PETTING

"Was there female hand on nude penis?"

FREQUENCY OF CUNNILINGUS IN PREMARITAL PETTING

"Was there mouth on female sex organ?" The "none but wants" category and "none and offended" category consist of those who volunteered this information; no question was asked.

FREQUENCY OF FELLATION IN PREMARITAL PETTING

"Was there mouth on penis?"

FREQUENCY OF APPOSITION OF NUDE GENITALS WITHOUT PENETRATION IN PREMARITAL PETTING

"Was there putting the nude sex organs together without going on and having intercourse?"

FREQUENCY OF TENSION AFTER PREMARITAL PETTINGS

"After petting, if you didn't come to climax or go on to have intercourse, were you left feeling tense, nervous, or upset?"

FREQUENCY OF ACHE AFTER PREMARITAL PETTING

"After petting, if you didn't come to climax or go on to have intercourse, would you get an ache or pain in (for males: the testicles; for females: the sex orgams or lower abdomen)?"

FREQUENCY OF MASTURBATION AFTER PREMARITAL PETTING

"After petting, if you didn't come to climax or go on to have intercourse, was there self-masturbation?" "How often?"

AGE FIRST ORGASM IN PREMARITAL PETTING

"How old were you the first time you came to climax from this petting?"

AGE-SPECIFIC INCIDENCE OF PREMARITAL PETTING TO ORGASM AMONG THE NEVER-MARRIED None. Figures obtained from age and frequency data.

FREQUENCY (MEAN) PER WEEK OF ORGASM IN PETTING AMONG THE NEVER-MARRIED

"How often did you come to climax by petting from (age at first experience) to (some salient point in life)?" Question repeated until pre-marital life span covered.

FREQUENCY OF RESPONDENT BITING IN SEXUAL ACTIVITY

"Do you gently bite or nibble your partner during petting or intercourse?" If affirmative, reply: "often, occasionally, or rarely?"

FREQUENCY OF AND RESPONSE TO BEING BITTEN IN SEXUAL ACTIVITY

"Does your partner bite you?" If affirmative reply: "often, occasionally or rarely?" and "Does it arouse you sexually?"

AGE FIRST POSTPUBERTAL COITUS

"How old were you the first time you had sexual intercourse, (put, had) the penis in the vagina?"

AGE OF FIRST COITAL PARTNER

"How old was (she,he)?"

TYPE OF FIRST COITAL PARTNER

"Was the first intercourse with a friend, a relative, someone vou were engaged to, or what?" Males were also asked "...or did you pay for it?"

VIRGINITY OF FIRST COITAL PARTNER

"Had (she, he) had intercourse before?"

VAGINAL BLEEDING AT FIRST COITUS

"Did she bleed?" or "Did you bleed?" If affirmative reply, the following question was asked: "How much?"

ENJOYMENT OF FIRST COITUS

"Did you enjoy your first intercourse much, some, a little, or not at all?"

DETRACTIONS FROM ENJOYMENT OF FIRST COITUS

"Did you enjoy your first intercourse?" If any negative or qualified response we asked "What was wrong?"

### AGE AT FIRST POSTPUBESCENT ORGASM IN COITUS

"How old were you the first time you came to climax in intercourse?"

TIME AFTER FIRST COITUS BEFORE ORGASM IN COITUS
"After your first intercourse, how long was it before you came to climax in
intercourse?" Coital frequency was checked to be sure that elapsed time without coitus was not counted.

### INTENTION TO HAVE PREMARITAL COITUS

"Do you think you will (have, have more) intercourse before marriage?" Asked only of the never-married. In the case of the married there was no question asked, but an automatic "no" was recorded if there had been no premarital coitus and a "will" if there had been.

### RESTRAINT ON PREMARITAL COITUS: MORAL RESTRAINT

"What prevented you from (having, having more) intercourse before marriage; were there moral or religious reasons?" If reply was affirmative, degree was asked.

## RESTRAINT ON PREMARITAL COITUS: LACK OF OPPORTUNITY

"What prevented you from (having, having more) intercourse before marriage; was there lack of opportunity?"

## RESTRAINT ON PREMARITAL COITUS: LACK OF INTEREST

"What prevented you from (having, having more) intercourse before marriage; was there lack of interest on your part?"

# RESTRAINT ON PREMARITAL COITUS: FEAR OF PREGNANCY

"What prevented you from (having, having more) intercourse before marriage; was there fear of pregnancy?"'

# RESTRAINT ON PREMARITAL COITUS: FEAR OF VENEREAL DISEASE

"What prevented you from (having, having more) intercourse before marriage; was there fear of venereal disease?"

# RESTRAINT ON PREMARITAL COITUS: FEAR OF SOCIAL REACTION

"What prevented you from (having, having more) intercourse before marriage; were you afraid of what people would think and say if they found out?"

AGE FIRST PREMARITAL COITUS AMONG THE NEVER-MARRIED

None. Data derived from answers to questions on age at first coitus, age at first marriage, etc.

AGE-SPECIFIC INCIDENCE OF PREMARITAL COITUS AMONG THE NEVER-MARRIED

None. Figures obtained from age and frequency data.

FREQUENCY (MEAN ) PER WEEK OF COITUS WITH COMPANIONS AMONG THE NEVER-MARRIED

"How often was there intercourse from (age at first coitus) to (some salient point in life)?" Question repeated until premarital life span covered. Activity with, or as, a prostitute was excluded or subsequently subtracted.

FREQUENCY (MEAN) PER WEEK OF COITUS WITH PROSTITUTES AMONG THE NEVER-MARRIED

"How often was there sex with prostitutes from (age at first experience) to (some salient point in life)?"

MAXIMUM FREQUENCY OF PREMARITAL COITUS IN ANY ONE WEEK

"What was the greatest number of times you had intercourse in any one week or period of seven days?"

NUMBER OF PREMARITAL COITAL COMPANIONS

"Not counting prostitutes, with how many different (women and girls, men and boys) did you have intercourse (up to marriage, up to now)?"

AGE OF YOUNGEST NORMARITAL COITAL COMPANION SINCE RESPONDENT WAS AGE EIGHTEEN

After ascertaining total number of nonprostitute coital partners up to time of interview, the question was: "What was the age of the youngest since you were age 18 or older?"

NUMBER OF PROSTITUTES IN PREMARITAL COITUS

"How many (women, men) have you paid for having sex with you?"

INCIDENCE OF COITUS WITH FLANCÉE?FLANCÉ

Incidence derived from question: "How long did you have intercourse with your (fiance, fiance, future wive, future husband) before the marriage?"

NUMBER OF PREVIOUSLY VIRGINAL COITAL PARTNERS After ascertaining total number of coital partners up to time of interview, the question was: "How many were virgins?"

## DURATION OF PREMARITAL FOREPLAY

"When you have sexual intercourse, how long a time do you generally spend in petting before the penis is put in the vagina?"

FREQUENCY OF MALE HAND ON NUDE FEMALE GENITALS IN PREMARITAL FOREPLAY
"In petting before the sexual intercourse, how often was there hand on nude female sex organ: much, some, little, or none?"

FREQUENCY OF FEMALE HAND ON NUDE PENIS IN PREMARITAL FOREPLAY
"Was there female hand on nude penis?"

FREQUENCY OF CUNNILINGUS IN PREMARITAL FOREPLAY

"Was there mouth on female sex organ?"

FREQUENCY OF FELLATION IN PREMARITAL FOREPLAY

"Was there mouth on penis?"

FREQUENCY OF POSITIONS IN PREMARITAL COITUS: MALE ABOVE, FEMALE SUPINE "How often was the male above with the female below, on her back?"

FREQUENCY OF POSITIONS IN PREMARITAL COITUS: FEMALE ABOVE, MALE SUPINE "How often was the female above with the male below, on his back?"

FREQUENCY OF POSITIONS IN PREMARITAL COITUS SIDE BY SIDE, FACING ONE ANOTHER:: "How often were you side by side, facing" one another?"

FREQUENCY OF POSITIONS IN PREMARITAL COITUS: SITTING "How often was it in a sitting position, face to face?"

FREQUENCY OF POSITIONS IN PREMARITAL COITUS: DORSO-VENTRAL

"How often was there intercourse with the female's back toward the male?"

FREQUENCY OF POSITIONS IN PREMARITAL COITUS: STANDING

"How often was there intercourse with both of you standing?"

FREQUENCY OF POSITIONS IN PREMARITAL COITUS: ANAL COITUS

"How often was there anal intercourse; putting the penis in the anus instead of in the vagina?"

RESPONDENT'S PREFERENCE REGARDING LIGHT DURING PREMARITAL COITUS

"Do you prefer to have intercourse in the light or dark?"

PARTNER'S PREFERENCE REGARDING LIGHT DURING PREMARITAL COITUS

"Did your (partner, partners) prefer to have intercourse in the light or dark?"

INCIDENCE OF NUDITY IN PREMARITAL COITUS WITH COMPANIONS

"How much of the intercourse before marriage was with both of you (nude, naked): none, little, some, or much?"

PREFERENCE FOR NUDITY IN PREMARITAL COITUS

Following the question as to nudity in premarital coitus: "Would you have preferred to have had it in the nude, with little clothing, some clothing, or fully clothed"

LOCATION OF PREMARITAL COITUS WITH COMPANIONS: OUTDOORS

"How much of the intercourse before marriage was outdoors?"

LOCATION OF PREMARITAL COITUS WITH COMPANIONS: AUTOMOBILE

"How much of the intercourse before marriage was in an automobile?"

LOCATION OF PREMARITAL COITUS WITH COMPANIONS: FEMALE"S RESIDENCE

"How much of the intercourse before marriage was where (the female, you) were living?"

LOCATION OF PREMARITAL COITUS WITH COMPANIONS: MALE'S RESIDENCE

"How much of the intercourse before marriage was where (the male, you) were living?"

LOCATION OF PREMARITAL COITUS WITH COMPANIONS: OTHER'S RESIDENCE

"How much of the intercourse before marriage was not in your or your partner's place, but in someone else's?"

LOCATION OF PREMARITAL COITUS WITH COMPANIONS: MOTEL

"How much of the intercourse before marriage was in a motel?"

LOCATION OF PREMARITAL COITUS WITH COMPANIONS: HOTEL

"How much of the intercourse before marriage was in a hotel?"

LOCATION OF PREMARITAL COITUS WITH COMPANIONS: BEACH

"How much of the intercourse before marriage was on a beach?"

INCIDENCE AND TYPE OF NONMARITAL PREGNANCY

These data derive from questions as to pregnancy which followed questions as to number of coital partners before marriage, during (excluding spouse), and after the termination of marriage. For males the question was: "Did you get (any of these women, this woman) pregnant?" For females the question was: "Did you get pregnant?"

FREQUENCY OF PREMARITAL USE OF CONDOMS

"How often were rubber condoms or fishskins used?"

FREQUENCY OF PREMARITAL USE OF DIAPHRAGM

"How often was a diaphragm used?"

FREQUENCY OF PREMARITAL USE OF WITHDRAWAL

"How often was withdrawal, pulling out the penis before coming to climax, used?"

FREQUENCY OF PREMARITAL USE OF RHYTHM METHOD

"How often was the rhythm method or safe period used? That is, having intercourse at the time of the month when the woman is unlikely to get pregnant."

FREQUENCY OF PREMARITAL USE OF DOUCHE FOR CONTRACEPTION

"How often was only a douche used to prevent pregnancy?"

FREQUENCY OF PREMARITAL USE OF OTHER CONTRACEPTIVE TECHNIQUES

"How often were other (contraceptives, birth control methods) used? What were they?

TIME BETWEEN INTROMISSION AND EJACULATION OF PREMARITAL COITUS

"After the penis is inserted, how long does it take before (you come, he comes) to climax?"

CURRENT PERCENTAGE OF PREMARITAL COITUS RESULTING IN ORGASM FOR FEMALE

"What percent of the time (do, did) you come to climax in the intercourse(before marriage)?"

# NUMBER OF ORGASMS PER ACT OF PREMARITAL COITUS

"How many times (do, did) you usually come to climax in each intercourse-once, twice, three times, or what?"

# INCIDENCE OF REGRET ABOUT PREMARITAL COITUS

"Do you regret having had intercourse before marriage?" If reply is affirmative, a second question was: "Do you regret it little, some, or much?"

### INCIDENCE AND TYPE OF INCEST

"With what relatives have you had intercourse?"

#### DESIRE TO MARRY

"How much do you want to get married?" or "At the time of (your, your first) marriage how much did you want to get married?"

### DESIRE TO MARRY A VIRGIN

"(Do you, did you) want to marry a virgin?" if necessary, questions were asked to ascertain degree of desire.

### AGE AT FIRST MARRIAGE

"Have you ever been married?" For lower socioeconomic level respondents the following phrase was added, "...or lived common law for a whole year or more?"

If the response was affirmative, the next question was "How old were you when you (married, started living common law)?"

# MALE AGE AT RESPONDENT'S FIRST MARRIAGE

"How old (were you, was he) when you (married, married the first time)?"

# FEMALE AGE AT RESPONDENT'S FIRST MARRIAGE

"How old (were you, was she) when you (married, married the first time)?"

## STATUS OF FIRST MARRIAGE

Following an affirmative answer to the question "Have you ever been married or lived common law for as long as a year?" were probe questions "Are you living together?", "Are you separated, divorced or widowed?" etc.

# LEGAL STATUS OF FIRST MARRIAGE

"Is the marriage legal or common law?"

# INCIDENCE OF TERMINATED FIRST MARRIAGE

"Are you living together?" If the response was negative, inquiry was made as to separation, divorce, or death.

#### NUMBER OF MARRIAGES

None. The figure was derived from the total of legal and common law marriages.

### NUMBER OF LEGAL MARRIAGES

"How many legal marriages have you had?"

#### NUMBER OF COMMON LAW MARRIAGES

"How many times have you lived common law for a whole year or more?"

#### DURATION OF FIRST MARRIAGE

"How long was the first marriage?" or if the respondent is married once and still married, calculate from age at marriage to age at interview and ask for confirmation: "That means you have been married (months, years)?"

TIME RESPONDENT KNEW FUTURE SPOUSE BEFORE MARRIAGE

"How long did you know (him, her) before you married?"

DURATION OF ENGAGEMENT BEFORE FIRST MARRIAGE

"Were you formally engaged? For how long?"

RELIGION OF FIRST SPOUSE

"What (was, is) your (husband's, wife's) religion?"

DEGREE OF RELIGIOUS DEVOUTNESS OF FIRST SPOUSE

"How often (did, does) (he, she) go to (Church, Synagogue)?"

EDUCATION OF FIRST SPOUSE

"How far did (he, she) go in school?"

TIME ELAPSED BETWEEN MARRIAGE AND FIRST MARITAL COITUS IN FIRST MARRIAGE

"Did you have intercourse the same day you married?" If negative reply, a second question was asked: "How long did you wait?"

REASONS FOR DELAYING CONSUMATION OF FIRST MARRIAGE MORE THAN TWENTY-FOUR HOURS

"Why did you wait?"

#### NUMBER OF CHILDREN DESIRED

For the never-married, "Do you want children?" if affirmative reply, "How many?" For the married, "At the time you married, did you want children?" if affirmative reply, "How many?"

#### STERILITY IN FIRST MARRIAGE

None. Derived from inspection of record, especially portion dealing with contraception and reproduction.

#### TIME BEFORE FIRST BIRTH IN FIRST MARRIAGE

"How long was it between the time you married and the birth of the first child?"

#### NUMBER OF MALE LIVE BIRTHS IN FIRST MARRIAGE

"How many children (have you had, did you have) in (this, that) marriage?" "How many boys?"

#### NUMBER OF FEMALE LIVE BIRTHS IN FIRST MARRIAGE

"How many children (have you had, did you have) in (this,that) marriage?" "How many girls?"

### NUMBER OF SPONTANEOUS ABORTIONS IN FIRST MARRIAGE

"If no children born in themarriage: "How many pregnancies (have there been, were there) in the marriage?" plus, if an affirmative response was given, "How many were miscarriages or other accidental losses?" If children were born the question was "In addition to your children, how many other pregnancies (have there been were there) in the marriage?" plus the follow-up question if an affirmative response was given.

#### NUMBER OF INDUCED ABORTIONS IN FIRST MARRIAGE

After ascertaining the number of pregnancies exclusive of those which resulted in live birth: "How many were intentional, induced abortions?"

### NUMBER OF MALE CHILDREN IN FIRST MARRIAGE NOT CONCEIVED BY RESPONDENT

A series of questions were asked: "Where were you born? You lived there up to what age? Then where did you go?" etc. until the current residence and age was reached.

BELINQUENT SAMPLE: INCIDENCE OF INCARCERATION

None. Persons interviewed in prison or jail were asked as to their convictions and dispositions. Later their official records were examined. Persons not interviewed in prison or Jail, but with illegal or borderline occupations were asked as to their convictions and dispositions.

DELINQUENT SAMPLE: INCIDENCE OF CONVICTION FOR SEX OFFENSE

None. The data represent a combination of the individual's description of each case plus the information from official records.
