SUMMARY

WILLIAM L. YARBER is Provost Professor in the School of Public Health – Bloomington, senior scientist at The Kinsey Institute, adjunct professor of family medicine in the Indiana University School of Medicine – Bloomington, and the senior director of the Rural Center for AIDS/STD Prevention at Indiana University, Bloomington, Indiana.

Dr. Yarber, who received his doctorate from Indiana University, has authored/co-authored nearly 175 scientific reports on sexual risk behavior and AIDS/STD prevention in professional journals and has received nearly \$4 million in federal grants (National Institutes of Health, U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, U.S. Department of Agriculture) to support his research and AIDS/STD prevention efforts. He is a member of the international Kinsey Institute Condom Use Research Team (KI-CURT) comprised of researchers from Indiana University, University of Kentucky, University of Guelph (Canada), and University of Southampton (United Kingdom). For two decades, with federal and institutional research support, KI-CURT has investigated male condom use errors and problems and has developed behavioral interventions for men, women and couples designed to improve correct condom use consistent with sexual pleasure.

He authored four school AIDS/STD prevention education curricula (student book and instructor guide) published by professional organizations: (1) *STD: A Guide for Today's Young Adults* (1985); (2) at the request of the U.S. government, Dr. Yarber authored the country's first secondary school AIDS prevention education curriculum, *AIDS: What Young People Should Know* (1989, 1987); (3) *Looking into AIDS* (1989); and *STDs and HIV: A Guide for Today's Young Adults* (2003, 1993).

Dr. Yarber founded and co-edited the *Handbook of Sexuality-Related Measures* (2019, 2011, 1998, 1988). He is the lead author of *Human Sexuality: Diversity in Contemporary Society* (Yarber, W., & Sayad, B., 10th edition, 2019, McGraw-Hill), a college human sexuality textbook used in over 300 colleges and universities nationwide. This book was translated, in 2012, into Chinese and published by the Beijing World Publishing Company as the most up-to-date book on human sexuality published in China in the past half century. This text was cited by a Chinese sexuality-related website as a "must-read" text by Chinese people, along with books by Kinsey and Freud. The text was translated and published in Korea in 2012. In 2018, it was published in Taiwan and is considered the beginning of reformed sexuality education in Taiwan.

Dr. Yarber chaired the National Guidelines Task Force, which developed the *Guidelines for Comprehensive Sexuality Education: Kindergarten–12th Grade* (1991, 1996, 2004), published by the Sexuality Information and Education Council of the United States (SIECUS) and adapted in six countries worldwide. He also developed the conceptual framework for the *Guidelines*. Dr. Yarber is past president of The Society for the Scientific Study of Sexuality (SSSS) and a past chair of the SIECUS board of directors. His awards include the SSSS Distinguished Scientific Achievement Award; the Professional Standard of Excellence Award from the American Association of Sex Educators, Counselors, and Therapists; the Indiana University President's Award for Distinguished Teaching; and the inaugural Graduate Student Outstanding Faculty Mentor Award at Indiana University.

Dr. Yarber has been a consultant to the World Health Organization Global Program on AIDS as well as sexuality and HIV/STI-related organizations in Brazil, China, Jamaica, Poland, Portugal, and Taiwan. He regularly teaches undergraduate and graduate courses in human sexuality. He was previously a faculty member at Purdue University and the University of Minnesota, as well as a public high school health science and biology teacher. He endowed at Indiana University, for perpetuity, the world's first professorship in sexual health, the William L. Yarber Endowed Professorship in Sexual Health. He also endowed the Ryan White and William L. Yarber Lecture Series.

Condom Use Errors and Problems

The Kinsey Institute Condom Use Research Team (KI-CURT) is an internationally recognized, multidisciplinary team that was formed in 2000 and is vested in advancing global sexual health through its research on the behavioral aspects of male condom use. KI-CURT is comprised of KI senior scientists Stephanie A. Sanders and **William L. Yarber** at Indiana University and KI research fellows Cynthia A. Graham at the University of Southampton, United Kingdom; Richard A. Crosby at University of Kentucky; and Robin R. Milhausen of the University of Guelph, Ontario.

KI-CURT has published over 50 articles and two book chapters on various condom use-associated variables such as pleasure, sexual arousal, fit and feel, use errors and problems, erection difficulties, circumcision status, motivation, self-efficacy, relationship type, and alcohol and drug use. In 2012 KI-CURT edited a special issue of the journal *Sexual Health: Condom use to prevent sexually transmitted infections: a global perspective*.

Several of KI-CURT's projects have focused on identifying barriers to condom use among Black men who have sex with men (MSM) in the Deep South and implementing educational programs to increase condom use efficacy among this population. This focus among Black MSM is particularly significant given that this population is disproportionately impacted by HIV/AIDS. The U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention states that Blacks are the racial/ethnic group most affected by HIV in the United States and that MSM account for a majority of new HIV diagnoses among African Americans.

A recent highlight of KI-CURT's work was the development of home-based and clinic condom use educational programs for men, women, and couples based on the findings of KI-CURT's prior observational research and behavior-change theory. KI-CURT, in collaboration with the Indiana University Rural Center for AIDS/STD Prevention (RCAP), has created several interventions designed to increase correct and consistent condom use that are consistent with sexual pleasure. These include *The Kinsey Institute Homework Intervention Strategy (KI-HIS)*, which has been tested for men who have sex with men (MSM) and men who have sex with women resulting in manuscripts published in the *Journal of Men's Health* (2011) and the *Journal of American College Health* (2014). Further pilot testing of *KI-HIS* among African American men was funded by a R21 National Institutes of Health grant. The *KI-HIS* has also been adapted for use in the United Kingdom (*KI-HIS-UK*) and with UK federal funding the intervention is currently being evaluated in a clinical trial in contrast to a clinic-based version with chlamydia infection as a biomedical marker of efficacy.

A condom-focused intervention for tourism workers, *Tourism Worker Intervention Safer Sex Training (KI-TWIST)*, was pilot tested in a major tourism destination in Canada and published in *The Canadian Journal of Human Sexuality* (2016). KI-CURT recently pilot tested a condom intervention for women on the Indiana University-Bloomington (IUB) campus, *Home-based Exercises for Responsible Sex (KI-HERS (W. Yarber, PI))* and the findings were reported in the *Journal of American College Health* (2018). A similar condom-based program for both mixed-sex couples, *The Home-based Exercises for Increasing Responsible Sex (KI-THEIRS)* was piloted tested among same-sex couples on the IUB campus and has been submitted for publication (W. Yarber, PI). Using the prior intervention models, a pilot test of a home-based, self-guided program with emphasis on condom-use negotiation and pleasure was pilot tested among men who have sex with men at IUB campus (W. Yarber, PI).

In April 2020 and early 2021 KI-CURT conducted a similar national study (Qualtrics) of the impact of COVID-19 on marital quality, and sexual behavior and satisfaction, and reproductive health among married 1000+ individuals ages 30-50 years. The results of the April 2020 study were presented at the annual meeting of Society for the Scientific Study of Sexuality and in reported in the *New York Times*. Manuscripts of the 2021 survey are currently in preparation.
